



To enable our students to gain a broader understanding of the sports industry, we organise residential stays and trips to other campuses and stadiums.

Over the previous two years our students have had the opportunity to visit Aberystwyth University, the Etihad Stadium, and St George's Park. These experiences have allowed them to gain an insight into the professional world.

Alongside these trips, students have also been able to achieve supplementary qualifications, such as the FA Playmaker Award, to boost their skills.



Part of our regular teaching schedule is made up of regular fixtures against other college and university teams.

These fixtures take place both home and away, allowing students to visit other grounds and represent Shrewsbury Town FC with pride whilst playing on their home turf.

Since the launch of Shrewsbury Town College and University we have played over 80 games against other teams, allowing students to apply what they have learnt in training sessions.



Portugal

We believe that students should be able to experience the different cultures that surround sport, therefore by offering overseas educational trips to stadiums and training facilities students have access to the wider industry and can set their sights on the future.

In 2023 our second year students visited Portugal to tour the Benfica Stadium, train at state of the art facilities at Footlab, and take in what Portugal has to offer.

Our aim is to provide more exciting international trips in the near future.

Increasing confidence in what we were doing and an obvious appetite among young people locally to embark on our brand of sports-related courses with its unique balance of the practical and the academic encouraged us to grow. So much so that, whilst partnerships have changed our ambition to provide young people in

Shropshire with a high-quality and relevant education has grown and is now a well-established pathway to employment, further training and University.

As the number of students has grown, we have had to expand our accommodation.
